NOTES

1. A candidate for the position of Trustee of WAIPA NETWORKS TRUST does not need to be a Connected Consumer of Waipa Networks Ltd but the person nominating them must be.
 2. Eligibility: The following persons shall not be eligible for election or appointment as a Trustee and may not hold office as a Trustee:
 - (a) Bankrupt: a bankrupt who has not obtained a final order of discharge or whose order of discharge has been suspended for a term not yet expired, or is subject to a condition not yet fulfilled, or to any order under Part 3 of the Insolvency Act 2006;
 - (b) Conviction: a person who has been convicted of any offence punishable by a term of imprisonment of 2 or more years unless that person has obtained a pardon or has served the sentence or otherwise suffered the sentence imposed upon that person;
 - (c) Imprisonment: a person who has been sentenced to imprisonment for any offence unless that person has obtained a pardon or has served the sentence;
 - (d) Restraining Order: a person to whom an order made under sections 382, 383 or 385 of the Companies Act 1993 applies;
 - (e) Mentally Disordered: a person who is mentally disordered within the meaning of the Mental Health (Compulsory Assessment and Treatment) Act 1992;
 - (f) Property Order: a person who is subject to a property order made under section 30 or section 31 of the Protection of Personal Property Rights Act 1988;
 - (g) Parliamentary elector: a person who is not a parliamentary elector for the purposes of the Electoral Act 1993;
 - (h) Director or Employee of Company: a person who currently holds office as a director of or is employed by the Company.
 3. A candidate cannot nominate themselves for the Trust.
 4. A candidate may be nominated under a name which the candidate is commonly known provided that the name will not:
 - cause offence to a reasonable person
 - be unreasonably long
 - include or resemble an official rank or title
 - cause confusion or mislead electors
 5. A candidate may provide a candidate profile statement including a recent photograph for dispatch to electors with the voting documents. For further information about candidate profile statements please see the candidate handbook.
